El Aroya de la Deesa, John Adle being present, to give him the possession I was ordered to give him; accordingly, it being on the same place of the Aroya de la Deesa, after inquir-ing if there were neighbors on the limits or boundaries of the said land, in order to have them called, to be convinced that the said tract of land does not belong to Pablo Babit Laffitt, said Pablo gives it as a donation to said Adle, permitting him to apply for and obtain the grant of the Aroya de In Deesa, who asks half a league on each of four courses, as stated in his petition.
